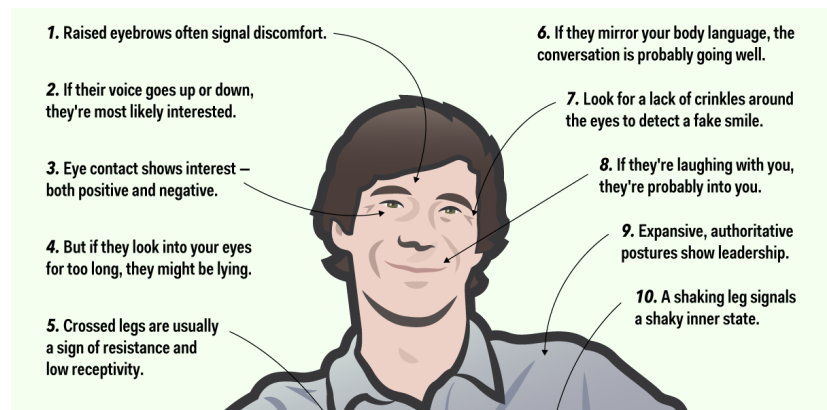
2. Communication Skill
